

## GRASSES BY RHODES' GARDEN FRESH 2008 SEASON

- **hakonechloa** "Aureola" *hakone* grass shade tolerant cascading grass with yellow and variegated leaves, 12-24"
- **liriope** "Dwarf Mondo" *lilyturf*, a fine-leaved member of the family reaching only 4"-6"
- **liriope** "Okina" *lilyturf*, new leaves emerge snowy white, then fade to misted frosty green
- **liriope** "Silver Dragon" *lilyturf*, 12-18" evergreen grass-like member of lily family, good groundcover or filler for sun or shade
- **miscanthus** "Super Stripe" showy banded grass has lush green foliage marked with tightly spaced bands of gold, forms a tall, arching clump topped with tawny plumes in early fall, up to 7'
- **muhlenbergia** c. tidy clumps of very fine blue foliage all summer, by late summer, plant explodes into bloom with clouds of airy pink blooms that last for weeks, to 3'
- **ophiopogon planiscapus arabicus** "Black Mondo Grass", one of the blackest plants available, loves the shade, 6-8" blades accented with lavender-pink flower spikes followed by black berries
- **panicum** "Huron Solstice" *red switch grass* blue-green leaves turn wine-purple in early summer, upright habit, deep purple flowers, to 4'
- **panicum** "Prarie Fire" *red switch grass*, blue-green foliage begins to turn wine red by early summer rosy flower panicles appear above foliage, 4-5'
- **panicum** "Thundercloud" very large switchgrass, upright, blue-green foliage stands all winter, 7-8'
- **pennisetum** "Piglet" cute 18" fountain grass
- **sasa** v. "Nana" *dwarf Kuma bamboo*, slow spreading 1-2' bamboo, easily contained
