

## GRASSES AT RHODES' 2010

**arundo donax variegata** Green and creamy white variegated foliage is striking as a specimen or as a screen plant. Clumping habit helps to keep the giant manageable.

**chasmanthium** "River Mist" A new introduction that provides a striking green and white variegated foliage, the plant can reach heights of 30 - 36 inches., late summer and early fall brings the oats/seed

**festuca g.** "Elijah Blue" a durable blue fescue, forms clump of glaucous blue-green foliage

**hakonechloa** "All Gold" brilliant gold foliage glows in the shade, better vigor than other varieties

**hakonechloa** "Nicolas" excellent fall color sets this hakone grass apart from other varieties

**liriope** "Silver Dragon" *lilyturf*, 12-18" evergreen grass-like member of lilyturf family, good groundcover or filler for sun or shade

**liriope m.** "Royal Purple" wide dark green leaves, clumping habit larger deep purple flower spikes  
• mature height 12"-15"

**miscanthus s** "Huron Star" strong upright habit, purple flowering stems, and brighter fall color, the green leaves have a narrow white midrib and form an upright vase-like clump. 7'-8' tall

**ophiopogon j.** "Gyoku-ryu" superdwarf mondo grass only 2"-3" tall, staying in tight clumps

**ophiopogon j.** "Nana" dwarf mondo *lilyturf*, a fine-leaved member of the family reaching only 4"-6"

**ophiopogon planiscapus arabicus** "Black Mondo Grass", one of the blackest plants available, loves the shade, 6-8" blades accented with lavender-pink flower spikes followed by black berries

**panicum** "Cheyenne Sky" tight vase-like clumps of blue-green that turns wine-red by early summer, purple flowers
