

VINES AT RHODES' 2010

campsis "Mme. Galen"

trumpetvine vigorous vine, showy clusters of deep apricot flowers in summer and fall

campsis r. "Flava" *trumpetvine* bright cheery yellow flowers in summer

celastrus s. "Autumn Revolution" *bittersweet* produces berries on every plant without a mate, produces astonishing quantity of fruit that is double the size of the species

clematis "Aarabella", small, rosy-purple flowers, non clinging and free flowering all summer

clematis "Anna Louise" 5"-6" violet flowers produced May/June and aug/Sept.

clematis "Jackmanii" dark purple blooms June/July and September

clematis "Paniculata" small white sweetly scented flowers Sept/Oct, vigorous climber

clematis "Rebecca" very large flowers are stunningly magenta-red with creamy yellow anthers, exceptionally free-flowering, blooms May-June and August, flowers are 5-7".

clematis "Rouge Cardinal" deep, velvety, crimson flowers June to Sept.

clematis "Royal Velvet" free flowering compact plant, rich velvet purple-pink flowers May/June and Aug/Sept.

clematis "Silver Moon", silvery mauve flowers, June, July and late August, does well in shade

clematis t. "Gravetye Beauty", deep red tulip-like flowers, July thru Sept.

clematis t. "Princess Diana", miniature tulip-like flowers are light pink outside and deep pink inside, June, July and Sept.

clematis v. "Betty Corning", fragrant four petal flowers of light blue, July - Sept.

hydrangea a. "Firefly" yellow / green variegated climbing hydrangea

lathyrus l. *perennial sweet pea* delicate flowers of rose, pink or white appear prolifically all summer, 4-6'

lonicera "Goldflame" *honeysuckle*, woody vine prized for its fragrant rosy-red flowers from June til frost, shade tolerant

passiflora "Incarната" *hardy passion flower vine*, zone 5, vigorous clinging vine, fast growing to 15'+, exotic fragrant flowers of white/lavander/purple appear July to frost

schizophragma "Roseum" *false hydrangea vine*, beautiful clear pink lacecap-type flowers June-July, great on north facing wall or trained up a tall tree

wisteria "Blue Moon" large, showy lilac-blue flowers held in foot-long racemes like clusters

of grapes, sweet intense fragrance, blooms 3 times a season
